Diploma of Remedial Massage

The Diploma of Remedial Massage (HLT 50307) provides MCPT graduates with the highest-level industry qualification, which leads to many career options.

MCPT Graduates may also apply to Private Health funds for provider numbers, allowing clients to claim rebates for remedial treatments.

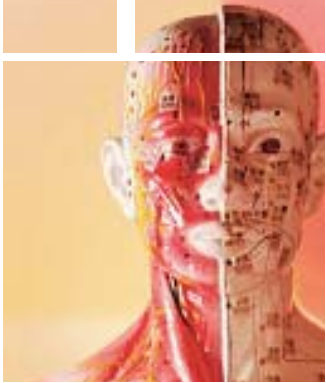
Graduates and may also apply for a Provider Number for Remedial Massage under the VWA - Victorian WorkCover Authority, which will allow them to treat work related injuries and obtain payment from VWA Insurers.

Remedial Massage Therapists utilise a wide range of specialised techniques to treat general and specific musculoskeletal problems, soft tissue injuries, and to assist in the prevention and management of injuries.

These injuries vary, however may be work related, stress related or sporting injury issues.

Remedial techniques can include the stimulating or sedating effects of Remedial Massage, such as facilitated stretching, lymphatic drainage, deep tissue techniques, trigger point therapy, myofascial release, mobilisation, etc.
